## **MOM Project**






Fourth meeting of the partners in Milan, Italy in January 2019

Since the last newsletter, we have had a meeting in Volos, Greece in June 2018 and our latest meeting took place in Milan, Italy in January 2019. During these meetings partners discussed the status of our two online MOOCs (Massive Open Online Course) for mothers and trainers and developed useful training materials.

The **MOM MOOC for Mums** is the complete multilingual online version of the face-to-face MOM training that was developed by partners in 2018. This massive free open online course aims to empower unemployed mums and boost their self-confidence. The online training will include exercises that help participants realise how skills developed through motherhood can be transferred to employability skills.





The **MOM MOOC for Trainers** will provide an opportunity to mentors, educators, trainers to learn about the face-to-face MOM Training and to deliver it to their clients. It will include an array of MOM materials such as videos, readings, and problem sets, and will provide interactive user forums to build an online community with mothers, trainers, and women on maternity leave.
